
Change the color easy by using Clipping Mask

This tutorial will help you understand how to Invert a layer and also how to use a Clipping Mask.


> We start with this little girl. I want to change her dress to another color.

The first thing is to cut her out.



Now I use Hue Saturation to change the color of her dress.

As you can see the color is now all over the girl. And I just wanted it on parts of her. If a already had a backround the backround also had been colored. And I dont want that, so I create a Clipping Mask.



Clipping Mask

Stand on the adjustments layer (Hue Saturation) and right click. Choose Create Clipping mask.

Stand at the same layer (Hue Saturation) and invert the adjustments layer.

Invert layer Ctrl + I

Now the color is hide.

Now I take a brush (middelhard) and white foregrounds color and brush. I stand on the inversed layer. And now I can brush the color where I want it.

And because of the Clipping Mask I can not brush outside the girl, its perfect!



Hue Saturation and change color again. I can play with the colors until I am pleased.

So when you start you dont have to find the right color, because its so easy to change.



Note!

A Clipping Mask is very useful when I only want to give a special layer some effect. If I dont use Clipping Mask the new adjustment will effect all the layers below.
